SPECIAL MEETING

The Board of School Trustees of the Northeast School Corporation met in Executive Session, 6:00 P.M., October 29, 2018 in the Superintendent's Office, Hymera, Indiana. All Board members were present. Also in attendance was Dr. Mark A. Baker, Superintendent.

The Board certifies that it discussed no subject matter other than the subject matter specified (IC 5-14-1.5-6.1): To receive information about and interview prospective employees, job performance evaluation of individual employees.

At the conclusion of the Executive Session, the Special Session was called to order.

RATIFY THE TEACHERS' MASTER CONTRACT

On a motion by Mr. Ransford and a second by Mrs. Greve, the Board ratified the 2018 – 2019 Master Teacher Contract. Said contract will be made a part of the minutes. The certified teachers will receive a onetime \$2,000 stipend and the Board will pick up the 5% increase on the health insurance effective 10/1/18. Also, the Board will contribute to their HSA: \$500 single plan /\$1000 family plan.

ADMINISTRATORS

The Board, on a motion by Mr. Ransford and a second by Mrs. Greve gave all eligible administrators a \$3,000 package and the Board will pick up the 5% increase on the health insurance effective 10/1/18. Also, the Board will contribute to their HSA: \$500 single plan/\$1000 family plan. (Said calculation is to be made a part of the minutes.)

SECRETARIES AND AIDES AND CORPORATION WIDE EMPLOYEES

On a motion by Mr. Ransford and a second by Mrs. Greve, the board gave approximately a 5% package which included a step up on the salary schedule and the balance of the 5% in a onetime stipend. The Board will pick up the 5% increase on the health insurance effective 10/1/18. Also, the Board will contribute to their HSA: \$500 single plan/\$1000 family plan. (Said calculation is to be made a part of the minutes.)

CORPORATION BUS DRIVERS AND BUS AIDES

The Board, on a motion by Mr. Ransford and a second by Mrs. Greve, gave the corporation bus drivers and bus aides approximately a 5% package. \$1.20 is added to each daily route and the rest is in a onetime stipend. The Board will pick up the 5% increase on the health insurance effective 10/1/18 and contribute to their HSA: \$500 single plan/\$1000 family plan. (Said calculation is to be made a part of the minutes.)

SUBSTITUTE TEACHER

On a motion by Mrs. Pinkston and a second by Mr. Frye, the Board approved Dawn Anglin as a substitute teacher/aide

The meeting was adjourned at 7:10 p.m. on a motion by consensus.
