North Central Jr/Sr High School Tardy Policy Effective Beginning January 6, 2020

We, at North Central strive to prepare our students to be responsible young people who grow into successful adults. We believe that being “on time” to school and class is a part of this growth.

Due to the excessive amount of “Tardies” this past semester (over 1,300) , beginning 2nd semester, January 6, 2020 the following “Tardy Policy” will be in effect.

“Any Student arriving after classes have begun at 8:05 AM must report to the main office for a pass to class and will be considered tardy. Students who arrive after 8:40 will be counted as absent to first period class. All tardies beyond first period will be recorded in Harmony by the teacher. Those tardies will be handled in the following manner.

1. Definition of a tardy - any student entering the classroom or assigned area after the bell rings will be counted “tardy”.
2. Steps of discipline for excessive tardiness: These are implemented per semester.
 - a. 5 total tardies - student will take all final exams and parent contact via letter
 - b. 10 total tardies - student will serve 1 day of in school suspension (ISS) and parent contact via letter and phone.
 - c. 15 total tardies - student will serve 2 days of in school suspension (ISS) and parent contact via letter and phone.
 - d. More than 15 tardies will result in OSS/RISE and possible loss of credits for the semester.
