

We are happy to announce that the USDA, which governs the National School Lunch and Breakfast Programs, has granted a waiver that allows all students to eat breakfast and lunch for free. This waiver will last until December 31, or until funds are no longer available. On Friday, Sept. 11, your student can begin receiving a reimbursable breakfast and lunch at no cost to you. However, parents will still be responsible for purchasing any extra ala carte items and for any negative balances in the student's lunch account. If you were considering filling out a free/reduced lunch application, please continue to do so. This waiver does not extend to textbook rental and when the program ends, those students without direct certification or an approved free/reduced application will still owe book fees.
